

APPLICATION FORM:

Please complete this application form and return it to The Secretary as soon as possible with the name of your proposer and seconder. On receipt of the form, **your name will be put on the Notice Board for two weeks**. After two weeks you will be written to requesting your fees. You then have ten days to accept the offer of Membership.

Send no fees until requested.

Fees are attached. The Fee is broken into Admission Fee, Subscription Fee and The Levy. The Combined Levy is payable for five years. The Extended Development Levy portion only is further payable for two years for court maintenance. Family members include parent (s) and their children under 25 years of age on the 1st January. Senior Members aged between 18 & 27 years (i.e. working, not student) are entitled to a reduction on the Subscription part of their fee only i.e. they pay the Student Subscription rate, Senior Admission and Senior Levy. The Club reserves the right to close any or all categories of Membership at any time. Application forms dated within 7 days prior to the closing of any particular category will be honoured. Renewal invoices are sent annually in January and **new Members joining mid-year should be aware that they will be invoiced again the following January.**

FACILITIES:

The Club is open 7 days a week from 9.00 am -11.30 pm

We have 12 new floodlit courts, showers, sauna, full bar, car parking and a function room which is available for hire for private parties. There is a Bridge Club and a Golf Society too. Apart from the Club Manager and a part-time Secretary, the Club is run on a voluntary basis by the Members. If you would like to volunteer please tick the appropriate box : Bar Duty Sub-Committee

The Club is represented in all Dublin Leagues from Class 1 to Class 7.

Tournaments are organised throughout the year for which a nominal entry fee is payable.
